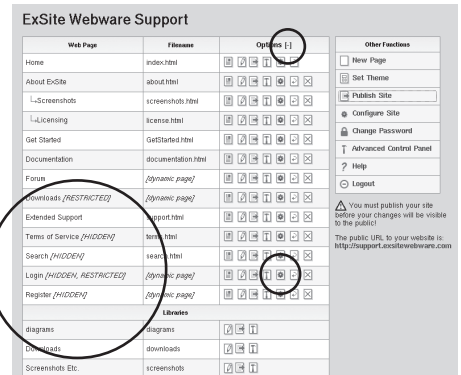

MySite

The **My Website** plug-in has an updated site map that includes some new features.

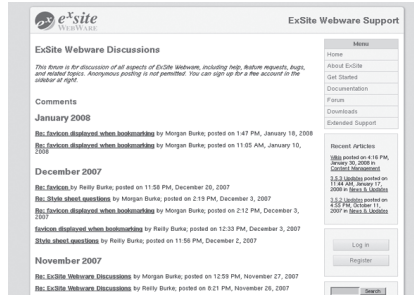
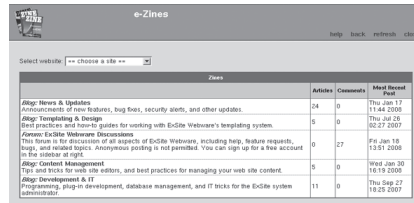
- Translated pages are also shown in the site map now, which makes it easier to manage multilingual sites.
- Hidden pages are now shown in their correct position in the site map, so you can organize them better. (Because hidden pages were lumped together at the bottom of the site map before, you might be surprised by their new corrected locations; if it turns out that their actual locations are not satisfactory, you can move them using the parent page and page rank settings under the "Configure Page" button.)
- When you select the Options [+] link to show some of the advanced functions, **My Website** now remembers this selection when you return to the site map.
- The width of the **My Website** HTML editor configurable so that it will integrate better with websites that have narrow layouts.



e-Zine

The e-Zine plug-in has been updated with many new features.

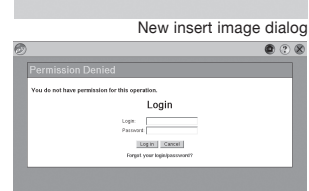
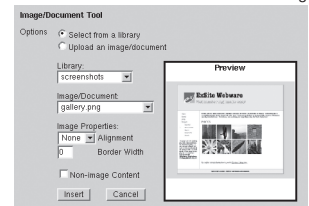
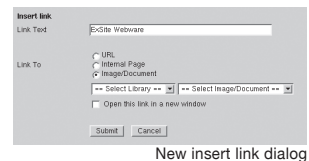
- Forum moderation has been enhanced so that moderators can approve and reject postings from their email.
- A new archive format allows you to browse the archives by date.
- New indexing methods include table and exploding indexes.
- New e-Zine formats include Wikis and PhotoForums (see below for an explanation).



The whole system is more customizable. Designers may also appreciate the new full-colour tool icons that can optionally be enabled.

Ease of Use

In the core tools, you will now find it easier to add images and documents into your pages with our improved image dialog in the HTML editor. It is also simpler to log in as an administrator, as the most common "permission denied" screens now automatically prompt for a your login info. Lastly, we have improved database security on the back-end, to better protect your website and data.



TYPES OF ZINES

Exware offers many different ways you can group and format your articles. If you use the e-Zine Module, you will have to select what format you want to use. The zine type determines the basic rules of zine behaviour, such as how indexes are displayed, whether you can add comments, and so on.

e-Zine

This is a generic e-zine. It accepts articles from a variety of authors, and displays them most recent first. Older articles are expired into the archives.

Books

Books are assumed to collect a series of articles from a single author. They are presented in a specific order (eg. as a series of chapters), and do not expire.

Blog

Blogs accept articles from a single author, much like a magazine column. They are presented most recent first, and eventually expire into the archives. They usually accept comments from readers.

Forum

Forums dispense with regular articles, and cut straight to comments from site readers.

PhotoForum

PhotoForums are like PhotoBlogs, except that any site reader may post a photo, and receive comments.

PhotoBlog

PhotoBlogs are similar to regular blogs, but they highlight the picture, rather than the text of the article.

Wiki

Wikis are cross-linked collections of articles, which any site reader may add to.

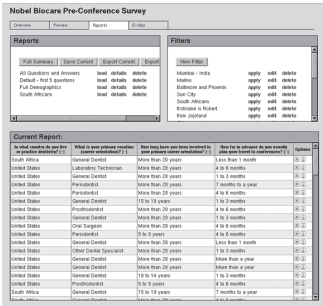

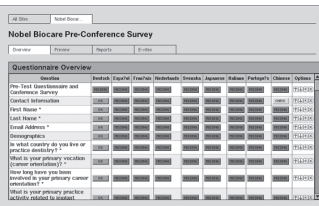

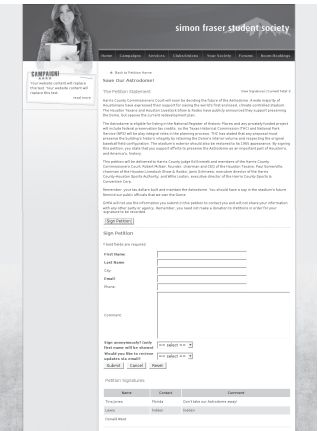
Paid Registration*

It is based on the SimpleRegistration module, with the simple addition of a single e-commerce fee that can apply to each form. In the past, clients could only incorporate e-commerce using our full blown Event Management module or a low-cost third party solution.

NOTE: This module requires that you have an e-commerce gateway such as: Authorize.net, Monaris, PayPal, Beanstream, etc.
